School Rules and Regulations

OBEDIENCE: Discipline being a prerequisite for success, immediate obedience is required to an order from the Head teacher or any other person in authority.

ATTENDANCE: Attendance and punctuality to all school programs should be seriously observed by all Student.

VANDALISM: All school property should be respected and should not be moved or borrowed without Permission from a member or staff.

LEAVING SCHOOL: Leaving school premises without written permission from the relevant authority will lead to expulsion. The school is not responsible for any problem that befalls on such a student out side the school premises.

VISITORS: These will be allowed at school only on specific official days and communication between Students and strangers is STRICTLY forbidden.

BRUTALITY AND DRUG ABUSE: Fighting, teasing and molesting other students as well as smoking and drinking are STRICTLY forbidden. Offenders will be liable for expulsion.

ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES: No electrical appliances like radios, cassettes, water heaters, mobile phone and their accessories etc will be permitted at school as well as cosmetic and jewelry and the like.

HONESTLY: Engaging in any act of dishonesty is a serious offence and will severely be punished. This includes; stealing, lying, examination mal-practices, forging or tempering will official record.

PUBLICATION: Anyone considering publishing and /or circulating information in the school magazine, or inviting an outside speaker must do it with full knowledge and permission from the patron and the school administration.

Any other rule and regulation may be given by the school.

REGULATIONS

(a)GENERAL

- (i) Prayers are a must to everyone.
- (ii) PUNCTUALITY TO ALL school activities and routine is MANDSTORY.
- (iii) Uniform must be worn on ALL school functions and should remain in fashion as
as
Provided by the school.
- (iv) Hair must be kept relatively short and natural and no cosmetic will be allowed.
- (v) Slipper, car tires (lugabire) must not be worn in classroom and on school compound.
- (vi) Every student is expected to take part in house and communal work.
- (vii) Students are not allowed to borrow money or share clothes from their fellow students.

(b)ACADEMICS

- (i) Classes are compulsory and students must work hard to meet the academic requirement of the school failure to meet the academic standards will result in a student being discontinued or made to repeat.
- (ii) Promotion is purely on merit should one fail to meet the academic standard, such a student will be given an opportunity to seat special exams at a fee which will be communication from time to time.
- (iii) Every student is expected to keep his /her note and past papers in an orderly manner as the school may need to check them from time to time.
- (iv) Cheating and copying during examination is punishable by discontinuing the student from the rest of examination for that session.

(c)DORMITORY

- (i) Every student is expected to participate in routine cleaning of their place of residence.
- (ii) Lights out shall be STRICTLY observed in the dormitories daily from 10:30pm.
- (iii) Dormitories are out of bound during class hours.
- (iv) No student is allowed to host a visitor in the dormitories.
- (v) A student must make his/her bed neat before leaving the dormitory.
- (vi) Day scholars are not allowed in dormitories.

(d)VISITORS

- (i) All visitors must present a valid visitors card (renewed) every after 1 year sign the visitors book on arrival before seeing their children.

- (ii) Before seeing their children all visitors must report to the offices concerned for permission. Student are not allowed to receive visitor any other day apart from visitation day except with special arrangement.
- (iii) Every visitor visiting a student must sign in the visitor's book in the Deputy's office stating clearly the reason to the visit and the same will be communicated to the parent.
